

## MANUFACTURING LIBERTY, ANTI-RACIST RACISM, HOPE REVIEWED, CITY IN THE COAL MINE



I. JSTARK1809: THE HERO WE NEEDED BUT DIDN'T DESERVE

The internet hero Jacob Dugyu, the German-Kurdish designer of the 3D printed <u>FGC-9 "pistol caliber carbine,"</u> who used the online handle "JStark1809" to protect his identity, was found dead in front of a car at his parents' home near Hannover, Germany, on October 9, 2021. This was two days after German police raided his own home, searching for evidence of unlicensed weapons and financial transactions related to his weapon designs. The police, ironically, declared his death as resulting from natural causes, "without any doubt."




Predictably, now that JStark/Dugyu is safely cold in the ground, his memory and legacy are now **under assault** by an establishment that has awakened to the fundamental paradigm shift he solidified, a shift in options for a public increasingly alarmed at **Establishment overreach** throughout the world.

In a word – the Establishment is falling back on the tried and true method of "slaying the messenger" (figuratively, if not literally...which is certainly a possibility) by denouncing Dugyu as an "incel," or "involuntarily celibate"...Basically, a loser who couldn't get laid if he wanted to.

This kind of **petty denigration** – more suited to juveniles in debased public schools – is the only real defense for an Establishment that now fully realizes the danger posed by technologies they, themselves, thought would **cement their power**.

In reality, they opened the proverbial "<u>Pandora's</u> <u>Box</u>."



#### A. KYLE RITTENHOUSE

Force is the mechanism that implements power in the world. The type of force deployed – whether physical, psychological, financial, etc. – depends on the circumstances, but the successful result is always a form of compulsion. Force, however, is a funny thing: if understood and applied appropriately, "force" can allow the weak to dominate the strong.

Case in point – **Kyle Rittenhouse**.

Anyone watching the news during "fiery, but mostly peaceful"-like protests in Kenosha, Wisconsin, on August 25<sup>th</sup> of 2020, should be aware of the story: Rittenhouse, then seventeen years of age, had gone to Kenosha with a group of armed men, to protect local businesses from rioters and vandals.

Rittenhouse had traveled to Kenosha from just over the border in Illinois, where he lived with his mother; his parents had separated in 2014, and his father lived and worked in Kenosha, where the younger Rittenhouse also worked at part-time jobs. Rittenhouse, armed with an AR-15-style rifle, attempted to *put out a fire* set by rioters in a car at a gas station.

It was at that point that Rittenhouse was set upon by the mob.

Several of the mob charged Rittenhouse, and attempts were made to *grab his rifle*. It was only at this point that Rittenhouse, attempting to flee the mob, began firing. Two were ultimately killed, and another was **grievously wounded** in the arm; the "victims" were definitely not the most shining examples of civic virtue, consisting of *a child molester*, *a violent domestic abuser*, and a paramedic who knowingly aimed a firearm at Rittenhouse. Rittenhouse was struck in the head with a skateboard as the mob pursued him and only made it to the police line a few steps ahead of the mob.

Rittenhouse was found *not guilty* of all charges.

The point of the above digression is that Kyle Rittenhouse, despite being a "legal adult" (a term that seems to have a very flexible definition in 21<sup>st</sup> Century America), was really a child. His attackers, in contrast, all ranged in age from 26 to 36, and two of the three had prior criminal convictions against them and had served prison time for their crimes. Clearly, all three of Rittenhouse's attackers were definitively "adults," in every sense of the term.

That being said, how did Rittenhouse – a child – manage to fend off three aggressive and **violent adult males**, at least one of whom was armed with a firearm himself (a concealed pistol, in fact, that the attacker acknowledged he was carrying in violation of Wisconsin law, as his concealed-carry permit was expired at the time of the riot), all of whom were attacking him?



The answer is simple: Rittenhouse was **armed with** an AR-15-style rifle and knew how to use it to protect himself from a **violent tyrannical mob** that was bent on murder, violence, and destruction.

And, of course, the violent and psychotic Left <u>in-</u> <u>stantly labeled</u> Rittenhouse as an "incel"...

Which brings us back to JStark1809.

#### **B. JSTARK1809**

Dugyu was **mortally offended** at the idea that his country of residence – Germany – made it virtually impossible for him to own and shoot simple firearms, much less anything "spicy," like a fully- or even selective-fire weapon. Dugyu had **committed no crimes**, and there is no evidence that he intended to do so.

Yet, faced with a government and police establishment that pointedly **did not trust him** (although, being fair, Germany's distrust of civilians possessing and shooting *any* firearm is at least **universal**), Dugyu turned to the cutting edge of home technologies – his **access to 3D printers**.

**1. BUILDING YOUR OWN LIBERTY** – Working carefully and diligently, Dugyu slowly built up his **knowledge of firearms technology** and applied it to his knowledge of 3D printing, following in the footsteps of greats like **P. A. Luty** and **Timothy Tobiason**, ultimately resulting in the **FGC-9** (named, literally, for "F\*\*k Gun Control – 9mm"), a pistol-caliber weapon that can be made with many models of 3D printers in a person's home workshop.

Dugyu would then take his most profound step: he released the design and specifications of the **FGC-9** online, for free, rather than trying to market the design commercially. This allowed anyone who could <u>a) find the file and b) assemble the correct raw materials</u> to produce their own copy – or copies – of the **FGC-9**.

**2.** THE FGC-9 – And be assured, this is no idle toy. The FGC-9 is very much a serious firearm, functionally better, by far, than anything produced by Luty, or the **STEN Gun** of World War 2.

Dugyu's first design quickly spread around the globe via the internet, and many hobbyists built FGC-9s to have fun with on private ranges, even going so far as to make them fully automatic, which is a very serious no-no in most parts of the world; even in the United States – supposedly the "Land of the Free" – building an FGC-9 (especially a fully automatic one) falls into a very gray area. The design's advantages, however, quickly made it "combat proven," as several guerrilla groups battling the military junta ruling Myanmar/Burma – and committing genocide, right, left, and center – began a form of mass production of the FGC-9 for their fighters, to give them something better than single-shot rifles and shotguns against the AK47-wielding army.

3. THE IDEA SPREADS – Inspired by Dugyu's success, other creators have "entered the chat," specifically <u>Hoffman Tactical</u>, who stepped the game up considerably by creating designs for <u>a mostly 3D printed</u> <u>AR-15</u>, "military adjacent rifle," called the "Orca."

Obviously, a weapon like **the Orca** significantly alters the calculus of strategy...but, in the end, they're "just" light infantry weapons. Right?

After all, <u>according</u> to the current President of the United States, <u>you need an F-15 more than you need a rifle</u> [Is F-15 correct?] in order to fight a government, an argument that seems to be a fixture in <u>the thoughts</u> <u>of Democrat Party leaders</u>.

But then...Hamas went and spilled the beans...let the cat out of the bag...left the barn door open...But I digress.

#### C. THE DIY ARMIES

On October 7<sup>th,</sup> 2023, the Hamas terror group launched a surprise attack on civilian communities in southern Israel. Amid the carnage – now, at last, *shown in full* to a Congress facing the reality of its abject failures – as Hamas slaughtered defenseless civilians, in what should have been a wakeup call to Israelis (*but may, in fact, not be*), Hamas opened the door for other groups – of any sort of militaristic intent – to step up their own games.

This goes far beyond things like <u>paraglider assaults</u> into drunken, undefended hippie raves, but into the guerrilla production of not simply <u>"dumb" artillery rockets</u>, but advanced <u>air attack drones</u>, and now – terrifyingly – <u>passively guided surface-to-air missiles</u>.

These are definitely not the micro-drone bombers that have been all the rage in videos from the wars in Syria and Iraq, against the Islamic State, to the Russo-Ukrainian War. Despite the hysteria hyped by mundane news services, those weapons were never the titans of the modern battlefield that they have been made out to be. While they can be dangerous, forces on the ground quickly learned to adapt to them, meaning that their effectiveness has dropped considerably since they were deployed.

Likewise, while the <u>uneducated were "amazed"</u> by Azerbaijan's use of drones to smash Armenia's air defenses, and then their conventional forces on the ground, nothing done in that <u>short war in 2020</u> was really "new," as such.

The only thing truly "new" was the ready availability of drones and drone strategies to the Azeri side; Armenia got lazy after their victories in the early 1990s and never bothered to upgrade their defenses, in a classic example of "Victory Disease."

1. ADVANCED DIY DEFENSE – The truly scary thing now, is that advances in the manufacturing sciences have developed to the point where serious, "military adjacent" hardware can be deployed by groups who were once limited to simple terrorism unless they received direct military support from a foreign power. This is not a situation that nation-states have faced since the middle of the 19<sup>th</sup> Century, when the technological difference between governments and civilian groups was merely a matter of scale rather than technological extremes.

As a single example, <u>video-guided missiles</u> scaled up to allow for both a simple warhead and a larger engine, present a serious danger to all but the fastest and highest-flying military aircraft, and present at least a moderate danger even to that craft.

2. LEVELING THE PLAYING FIELD — The work of pioneers like Jacob Dugyu and Hoffman Tactical has effectively leveled the playing field in ways that the Establishment can now see but does not know how to deal with. While the drone projects presented above may not represent much of a threat to modern battle tanks and combat aircraft, they are a definite threat to civilian aircraft and helicopters, even military ones.

#### PREDICTIVE ANALYSIS

The Establishment is **terrified at the idea** that they could **lose the advantages** they have worked so hard to gain in the last hundred years. They cannot take action to **curb 3D printing**, because there has been so much time and effort invested to adjust manufacturing to utilize new technology.

But, at the same time, they cannot **curb the common citizen's ability** to find and access these tools, both because the **Establishment needs that very ability**, and because they cannot control the hidden aspects of the global computer nets that they created.

And, as history has **proven repeatedly**, human beings are **far less predictable** than any algorithm.



As a result, **the Establishment cannot react** to people like **Kyle Rittenhouse** and **Jacob Dugyu**. Rittenhouse acted in legal self-defense, after being attacked while trying to help a community he lived and worked in for most of his young life.

Dugyu reacted to the insult of the German government's passive accusation that he could not be trusted with firearms simply because he existed, by using emerging technologies to level the playing field, effectively giving individuals the ability to make modern-day muskets in their homes.

For these offenses, the Establishment and their lick-spittles in the mainstream media are now castigating both men as "incels." These agencies are slinging these juvenile insults because they have no other mechanism to try and deflect the message to the masses that the masses can exercise force in reaction to tyrannical state enforcement of unjust laws if they so choose... proving the point that true power — both political and military — rests solely in the hands of the people, at large. The Establishment fears this turn of events...and is right to do so, as they are fresh out of friends and know it.

Jacob Duguy is dead. He may have died of natural causes, or his "heart condition" may have been given a "helping hand." JStark1809, however, very much lives on, as his design is helping to free people being brutally oppressed even as you read this article. His work will live on and develop, and even if it is misused by bad actors in the future, it has already paid its dues in the cause of actual Liberty and Justice.

JStark1809 is **the hero we needed** but did not deserve.

It falls to us to live up to his example.



Why What SEEMS To Be Undeserved Suffering In The Flesh Is Actually A Privilege, A Blessing, and a Joy

I'm going to get really vulnerable and transparent here because I am often asked how I handle a lack of physical intimacy with my wife, i.e., sexual relations. It's not advised to share such things publicly, and it could creep someone out, but I feel that there are too many people who need hope and help for themselves that, in such matters, for me, it is not good to keep this a mystery.

My wife, Dora, in case you don't know, is 58 and in an advanced Alzheimer's state. Recently, I was able to bring her back home from memory care, which is another long story as to why she went and what it took to bring her home again.

(I am not complaining here; I am being "in the real," and I want to convey the deeper joy that is so great that even what seems like suffering in this life is bearable and a privilege.)

Intimacy with my wife, and by this, I just mean **physical intimacy**, hasn't been possible since around early 2019.

**Spiritual and emotional intimacy** are all we can share now. They are, however, more important than physical intimacy, in my opinion. I am not complaining; this is more a praise report to **thank the Lord** than anything else, but it is also meant to offer hope and perhaps advice to people who are struggling with this.

"It is good for me that I was afflicted, that I might learn your statutes." —Psalm 119:71

So how do I endure without turning to things like porn or an affair? The answer is that I try to **stick close** to Jesus Christ every day, I lean on the Holy Spirit to help me, and, thankfully, by God's **grace and mercy**, the desires/instincts for such are **greatly suppressed**. You cannot make yourself not watch porn; the drive can be strong, but if you are **walking in the Holy Spirit** and the presence of God, the desire for that is offset and **nullified** even by the pure joy of being in **God's presence**.

(NOTE: I am not claiming I never looked at things I ought not or that I didn't struggle, albeit I most definitely never stepped out on my wife. What I'm saying is that when I stopped trying to fight the urge in my flesh, using man-made means, even when I was a "good boy," I was still miserable. However, when I saw this lack as a call to draw near to God, it became much easier to bear, and I am far from being miserable because of it.)

I won't judge people who stumble in these areas; I recognize how truly difficult this is. I consider it a **Grace from God** that He **supernaturally suppressed** this drive in me, allowing me to endure, and allowing me to transition to a state where I'm OK if physical intimacy is something I will never experience again. This doesn't mean I don't feel emotional pain, it is often somewhere near the surface, or I don't lose the victory at times. But emotional pain and struggle are not the highlights of my life; the **Joy of the Lord** is.

I'm not saying it's easy, and without Jesus Christ and being steadfast in seeking His presence, I can't say what would happen; even though my love for Dora is such that I have always felt any straying on my part would be akin to **doing violence** against her soul, something I could never forgive myself for doing.

This is something really personal and vulnerable to share, and I don't recommend everyone do such, but I feel people who are struggling need to know they are **not alone** and there is **hope and life** after sexual intimacy is taken away from you, or before you are married, which you should save that part of yourself for, and only for that.

I don't know if God will heal Dora or, if He chooses to let this disease run its course, how long I will need to care for her in this life; the very thought of losing her wrecks me inside like nothing else.



In the natural, I foresee a long road, perhaps years, unless God intervenes, in which my trials and tribulations in the flesh may get harder each week, month, and year. But I know that everything I endure in faith in this life will be rewarded immensely and beyond measure in eternity, and I strive to maintain an eternal view of life.

To be clear, the more I draw near to Jesus and have an eternal view, the more I see this as a **strong bond of love**, and I'm thankful for God giving me the **JOY of the fellowship** of His suffering, by which the <u>spiritual pleasure overcomes the seeming physical/emotional suffering</u>. To be able to draw near to Christ and experience His presence while, say, cleaning a toileting accident or staying up late to handle an emotional crisis is something that, when you experience it, you will understand why St. Paul the Apostle spoke of the **present suffering** as being so **light and temporary**.

My goal and my special covenant with God is to have <u>all knowledge</u>, <u>understanding</u>, <u>and wisdom</u>, but to get it, I must be willing to **walk into fire** without any hope of any guarantee the fire won't burn me. I think no physical or emotional pain in the flesh can compare to the **joy within my spirit**, and if this is the path to have that, I **thank God** for it. This isn't a doctrine everyone should follow; this is just <u>something between God and</u> me alone.

I also know Dora would take this road; she very clearly told me this, if that would **serve her missionary aim** of reaching more people for Jesus and using her story and undying faith to draw others to the Lord. For now, unless God heals her, Dora is **enduring in faith** something unimaginable, but her **love for the Lord** remains and still attracts people to the **Light**.

Asked if it is hard to endure a lack of physical intimacy with my wife, my answer is, "Not nearly as hard as just seeing her in this diminished state when she was so sharp, vibrant, and powerful in her natural state." And yet, even in this, the **Joy of the Lord** truly is my strength in ways I cannot explain.

I will say this: I have always wanted to **plumb the depth of God's love** and experience this joy, and nothing I am enduring now in the flesh really changes how thankful I am that **God chose me** to go down such a road to **experience Him** in this way.

I am thankful I had 30 good years with a woman who was in every regard as perfect a match to me as one could ever hope for. I have experienced **deep and abiding love**, such as many never see in this world. While at present it is hard, it is well worth all I have **already enjoyed**, and, what is more, the reward for **enduring in faith** is beyond comprehension!

If you are enduring what **feels like hell on earth** or if you are **loveless** still in this life and wish you weren't, I urge you to draw near to **Jesus Christ** and to take on an <u>eternal view of life</u>: your reward is immense and will satisfy you in the world to come **forever**.

My next phase is to **seek and allow God** to transform me so I can enjoy serving and not be focused on my own creature comforts and convenience. I like things "just so," but after bringing Dora home, I have to give that up and **find God's love and joy** in that.

And that's the bottom line!
